# International Whitsun Meeting 2026

Wine and History around the Donnersberg Mountain  
22 to 25 May, 2026

Dear MG friends,

When talking about "mountains in Germany", most will think of the black Forest or the Alps. But then there's the Donnersberg, the summit of the Palatinate. This is where the German MGCC has its "home," in the North Palatinate Uplands, there are many fantastic roads, worthwhile destinations, and, of course, stunning scenery. Together with a few local helpers, we're putting together a great program that we hope will inspire you.

The Donnersberg district, with its roughly 75,000 inhabitants, is rather sparsely populated, but it encompasses parts of three wine-growing regions: Nahe, Palatinate, and (a very small section of) Rheinhessen. These areas are waiting to be explored and experienced. However, some of the roads here can be a bit challenging, especially for older vehicles. With gradients of up to 25%, things could get a little exciting.

Therefore, we've come up with something special: On Saturday and Sunday, we'll ride in two groups. One group will take a shorter, less steep route, while the other will cover a few more kilometres and tackle more hilly terrain. We'll meet up for lunch at a common location on both days.

But of course, it's not all about wine – after all, you'll have to drive! We've selected a few sightseeing tours that will give you interesting insights into the history of a lesser-known region, from the Celts to the railway clock. All of this is complemented by a hotel that's reserved exclusively for us for the Pentecost weekend and offers not only plenty of comfort but also an excellent spa.

You'll also be spoiled for choice when it comes to food; Palatinate cuisine offers a wealth of delicious specialties. We're looking forward to seeing you and hope you have a wonderful time around the Donnersberg – the highest mountain in the Palatinate.

## The Programme

**Friday, 22 May 2026**

After checking in at the hotel, you have the option of using the on-site spa facilities or taking a stroll through the charming old town of Kirchheimbolanden.

**Saturday, 23 May 2026**

Nahe Wine Region

Today we'll travel in two groups to the Palatinate Museum of Time in Rockenhausen and to a wine tasting on the Alsenz River. We'll then meet for lunch at Ebernburg Castle, overlooking the Nahe River.

A seasonal menu awaits us at the hotel this evening.

**Whitsun, 24 May 2026**

Palatinate Wine Region

Divided into two groups again, we'll explore the history around the Donnersberg mountain. For lunch, we are going to drive to the Zellertal valley, a small section of Palatinate vineyards within our district.

We conclude the day with a gala dinner in true Palatinate style.

**Whit Monday, 25 May 2026**

Rheinhessen Wine Region

The optional excursion on Monday will conclude our Pentecost meeting with a light meal overlooking the Rheinhessen wine country.

**Registration Fee**

The registration fee of 300 euros per person includes all rally documents, entrance fees, and guided tours. Also included are all dinners at the hotel (Sunday includes a beverage package) and lunch breaks with drinks on Saturday and Sunday. Other beverages are not included in the entry fee.

**Accommodation**

After registering, we will send you a link to the hotel's website to book your rooms. All rooms at the Parkhotel Schillerhain are reserved exclusively for our event until end of February 2026!

Room rates including breakfast range from 105 euros (Standard Single Room) to 206 euros (Comfort Double Room) per room per night.

Ample parking is available, including for trailers! Electric MGs welcome, the hotel has its own charging stations.
